<p>Description of Property: No 16 Riverside Walk is a well presented 1st floor, 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom, and self-catering holiday cottage apartment situated in the heart of Malhamdale. Nestled alongside the River Aire in the pretty Yorkshire Dales village of Airton, No 16 forms part of a grade II listed former corn mill known as Airton Mill. Stunning riverside views and beautiful countryside can be admired from the apartment. Over 2 floors, No 16 offers accommodation for 2-5 people and provides an excellent base for many stunning walks and cycle rides. Conveniently, The Pennine Way/ Dales Way passes the front of the mill along the river. The apartment has its own entrance with stairs to the first floor which includes kitchen diner, bedroom 1 with king size bed, bathroom, living room and staircase to the newly refurbished loft space. The loft space includes a "Zip & Link" Super king bed, which can be split into 2 single beds if required, a further small single top bunk bed and en-suite with large walk in shower. There is a TV in the living room and the loft bedroom. Wi-Fi is included.</p>

<p>Distance to nearest city, town, village: The apartment is 3 miles from Malham, however Airton has its own Farm Shop and tea rooms.</p>

There is a steel railing either side of the steps, please take care in the winter in case it is slippy.</p>

There is no ramp / level access provided due to restrictions made by the National Park authorities there is no access to the property for wheelchair users.

The front door opening is 810mm.

There are exterior lights to the building. The ground floor entrance has a light switch that turns on lights on the first floor landing. This gives some light at the entrance but it isn't well lit.

The apartment entrance floor surface is hardwearing carpet with a doormat.

HALLS, STAIRS, LANDINGS, PASSAGEWAYS

The stairs from the entrance to the first floor are not well lit. The landing at the top of the first flight of stairs is well lit by ceiling lights. The second flight of stairs to the loft space is well lit by a spot light.

Describe the floor surfaces e.g. tile, wood, rugs, carpet (thick/short pile):

The hall and the stairs have oatmeal coloured carpets until it meets the kitchen.

Describe the stairs e.g. Number of steps, landings, handrail(s):

There are 13 stairs leading to the first floor landing with a handrail on the right hand side. This staircase has a width of 750mm from the wall on the left to the handrail on the right. There are 13 stairs leading from the first floor to the loft space. This staircase has a width of 600mm from the handrail to left to the wall on the right.

SITTING ROOM / LOUNGE

Describe where the Sitting Room / Lounge is situated and how you access it i.e. is there level access, ramp(s) or step(s)? If steps, how many?

You enter the Sitting Room from the first floor hallway to the right or from the kitchen.

What is the clear door opening width, taking into account any obstacles?

To enter the sitting room from the landing, you first go through a door with a width of 700mm. You then go through a further door with an opening of 640mm. The door opening is obstructed by the fact that there is a doorstop behind the door used to protect the television. Additionally, you can enter the sitting room via the kitchen through a doorway which measures 710mm wide.

Describe the layout within the sitting room/lounge. Is it level or are there steps? Are there large spaces between furniture, what type of seating and table are there e.g. high/low tables, couches, easy chairs?

The sitting room/lounge is level with plenty of space between the furniture. There are two three seater sofas, an armchair, two low tables and a table with wheels (hard to move). The TV hangs on the wall.

Is the furniture moveable?

The furniture has been laid out to make the best use of the space of the sitting room. So we would ask you to leave the furniture as it is.

Where there are TV's are subtitles/audio description available?

The television is made by LG, the remote controller has a subtitle button at the top left of it just below a circular button.

Describe how well/evenly lit the area is and what type of lighting is provided e.g. ceiling spot lights:

The Sitting Room has well-lit, dimmable ceiling lights and a table lamp.

There is an oatmeal coloured floor.

The opening to the Dining Room is 710mm.

Seating consists of five wooden chairs without arms.

The Dining Room is well lit with drop lighting.

The floor is made of Linoleum.

The kitchen is accessed from the first floor landing on the left or via the living room.

What is the clear door opening width, taking into account any obstacles?

The door opening is 715mm.

The hob is set into the work surface 920mm high

There is one oven with a drop-down front with a pull bar across the top which is 495mm long

The microwave sits on the work surface which is 895mm high

How high is the work surface/food preparation area?

The work surface / food preparation area is 895mm high

The highest shelf of the Fridge is 770mm

The lowest shelf of the Fridge is 270mm

The kitchen is a kitchen-diner so the dining room table is in the same room.

Describe how well/evenly lit the area is and what type of lighting is provided e.g. ceiling spot lights:

The kitchen is well lit with halogen ceiling lights and under counter lights.

State the height of wall cupboards containing crockery, glasses etc. Can these be moved to lower level cupboards on request?

The wall cupboards measure 1600 mm from the floor to the handle. The lower shelf of the wall cupboard is 1500mm from the floor. From the floor to the base unit, the handles are 570mm.

From the floor to the lower shelf of the base unit, the height is 90mm. The plate rack is 1370mm from the floor.

Loft space Twin Bed/Superking:

When setup as a superking, there is a space of 650mm to the left of the bed and 1090mm to the right of the bed. There is 660mm space to the end of the bed.

When the beds are setup as twin, there is a space of 650mm to the left of the left hand side bed, there is a gap of 600mm between the beds and 490mm to the right of the right hand bed. Again, there is 660mm to the end of both beds.

First floor bedroom: The space between the bed and the front wall is 570mm. The space between the bed and the radiator on the back wall is 550mm.

What is the height of the clear space under the bed (if any)?</p> <p>Loft space Twin Bed/Superking 620mm height to the top of the mattress. 0mm clear space under the bed as it's a divan.</p> <p>Loft space bunkbed 1750mm height from the floor to the top of the mattress. There are 6 steps on the ladder. The width of the step is 360mm.</p> <p>The first floor King-size bed 560mm height to the top of the mattress 220mm clear space under the bed.</p>
	<p>Describe the colour contrast of the floor, walls and doorways:</p> <p>All bedrooms are white with oatmeal carpet.</p>
	<p>Describe the wardrobe and storage space e.g. can rails be adjusted?</p> <p>Loft space Twin Bed/Superking has a five drawer chest of drawers. It also has a hanging rail which is 1520mm from the floor.</p> <p>First floor bedroom has a small, two drawer bedside cabinet. A hanging rail that measures 1860mm from the floor.</p>
